2001 Foundation of EUROKOMBI as a joint venture of

- Eurogate Container Terminal Hamburg GmbH and
- Kombiverkehr, Deutsche Gesellschaft für kombinierten Güterverkehr mbH & Co. KG, Frankfurt/Main (each with 50 %).

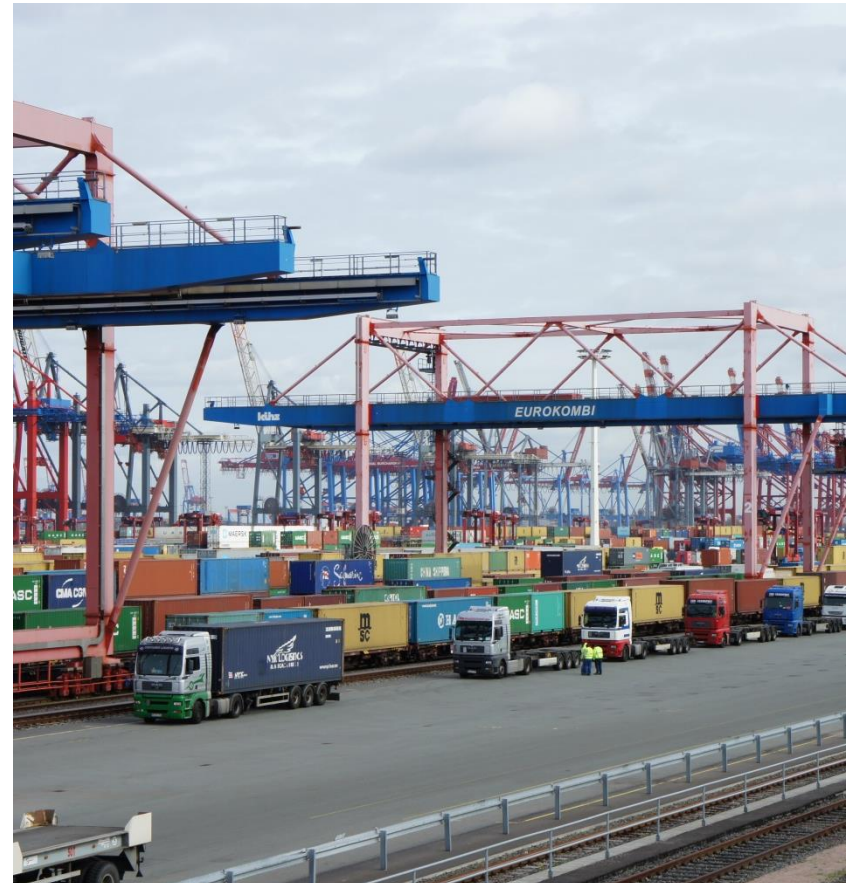
2002 Initial operation of module 1

- 3 Rail Mounted Gantries (RMG)
- 5 tracks (each with 720 m)

2004 Expansion of module 1 by one RMG and one additional 650 m track.

2009 Expansion of operating sector by module 2

- 4 RMGs
- 5 720 m tracks

EUROKOMBI & EUROGATE – Located in the very heart of Germany’s largest seaport with all serviced needed for intermodal transport

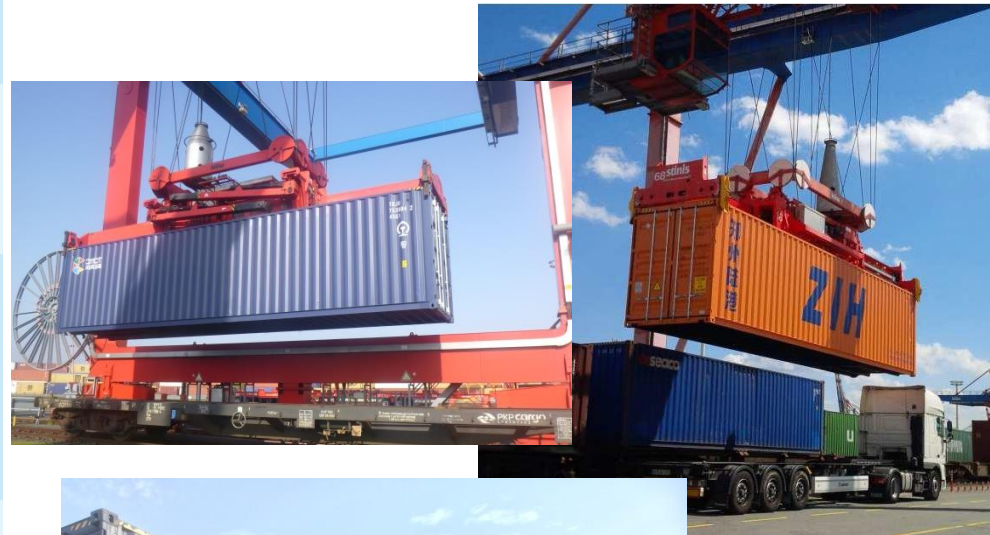


EUROKOMBI – Your railway station in Hamburg



EUROKOMBI Terminal, Hamburg – Largest railway station for combined freight transport in Germany and possibly a main hub for the China-Europe trains

|-------------------|---|
| Area | 161,000 m ² |
| Handling capacity | 700.000 cargo units |
| Tracks | 10 handling tracks, each 700 m in length as well as 1 handling track with 640 m in length |
| Cranes | 8 RMG-cranes each with 41 tonnes loading capacity, spreaders with gripper gear |
| Equipment | 1 reach stacker as well as 3 multi-trailer trains with 3x40' trailers each |



Train arrivals and departures

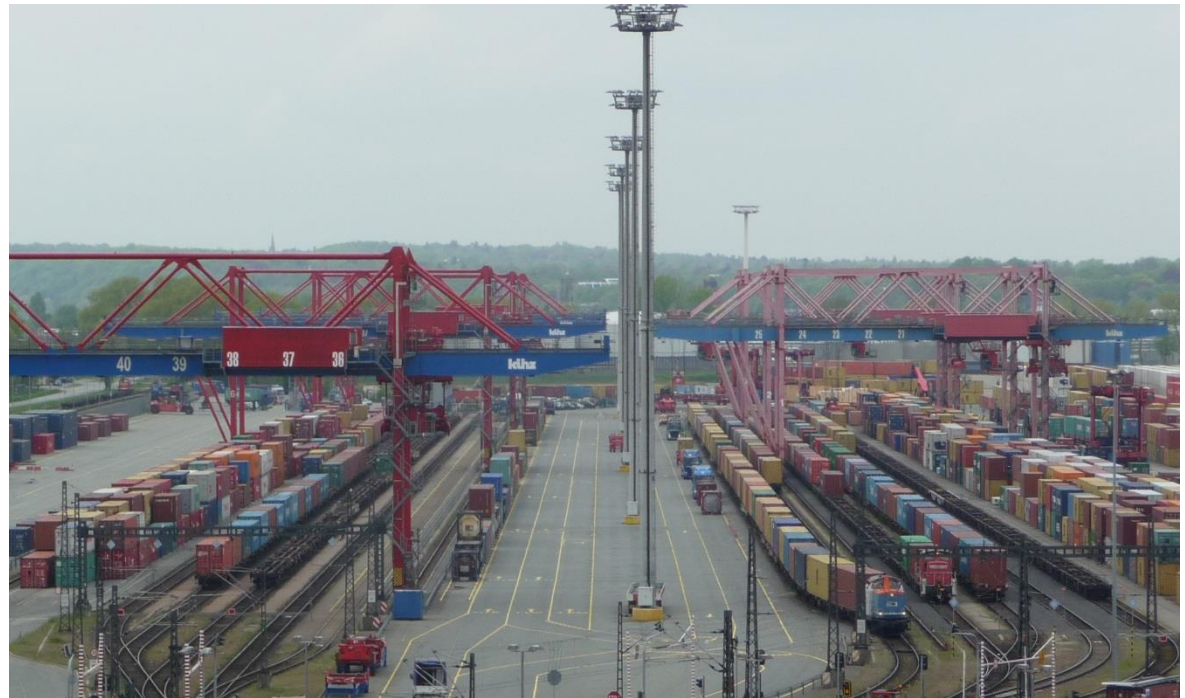
- 33 trains / day
- 174 trains / week

Portal crane

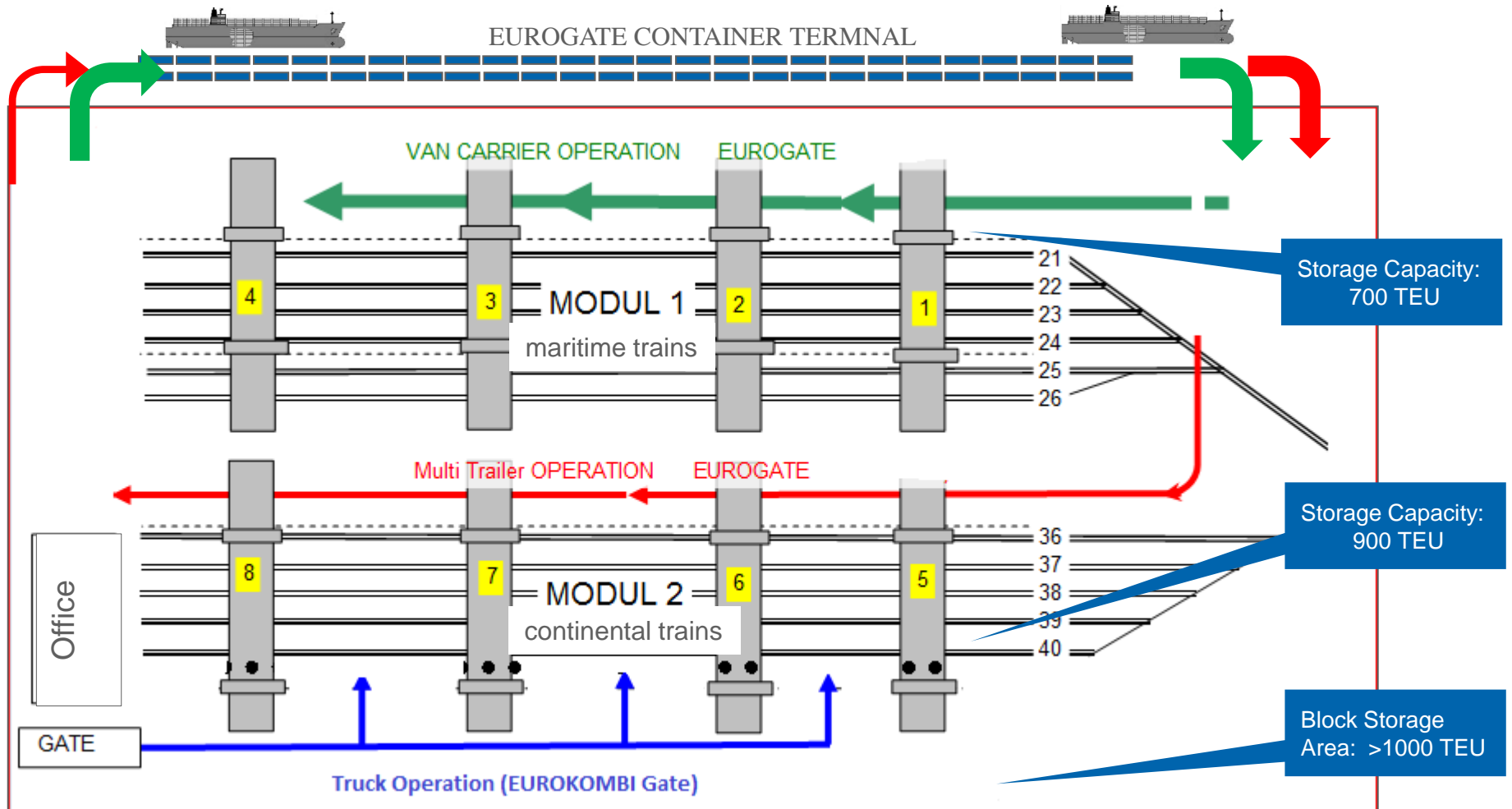
- 192 moves / hour
- 2,169 moves / day
- 48,510 moves / month
- 500,595 moves / 2016
(=808.000 TEU)

Truck Gate

- 750 trucks / day
- 2,500 trucks / week



Container-Operation & Storage Capacity



Rail network

- 21 operators (forwarders) organize rail systems from/to EUROKOMBI
- Maximum coverage: over 40 destinations in Germany and 15 destinations across Europe

Feeder connections

- EUROGATE Container Terminal Hamburg right next to EUROKOMBI
- Seamless transfer to main vessels and feeder vessels at the container terminal
- Shipping connections to all main European and global ports

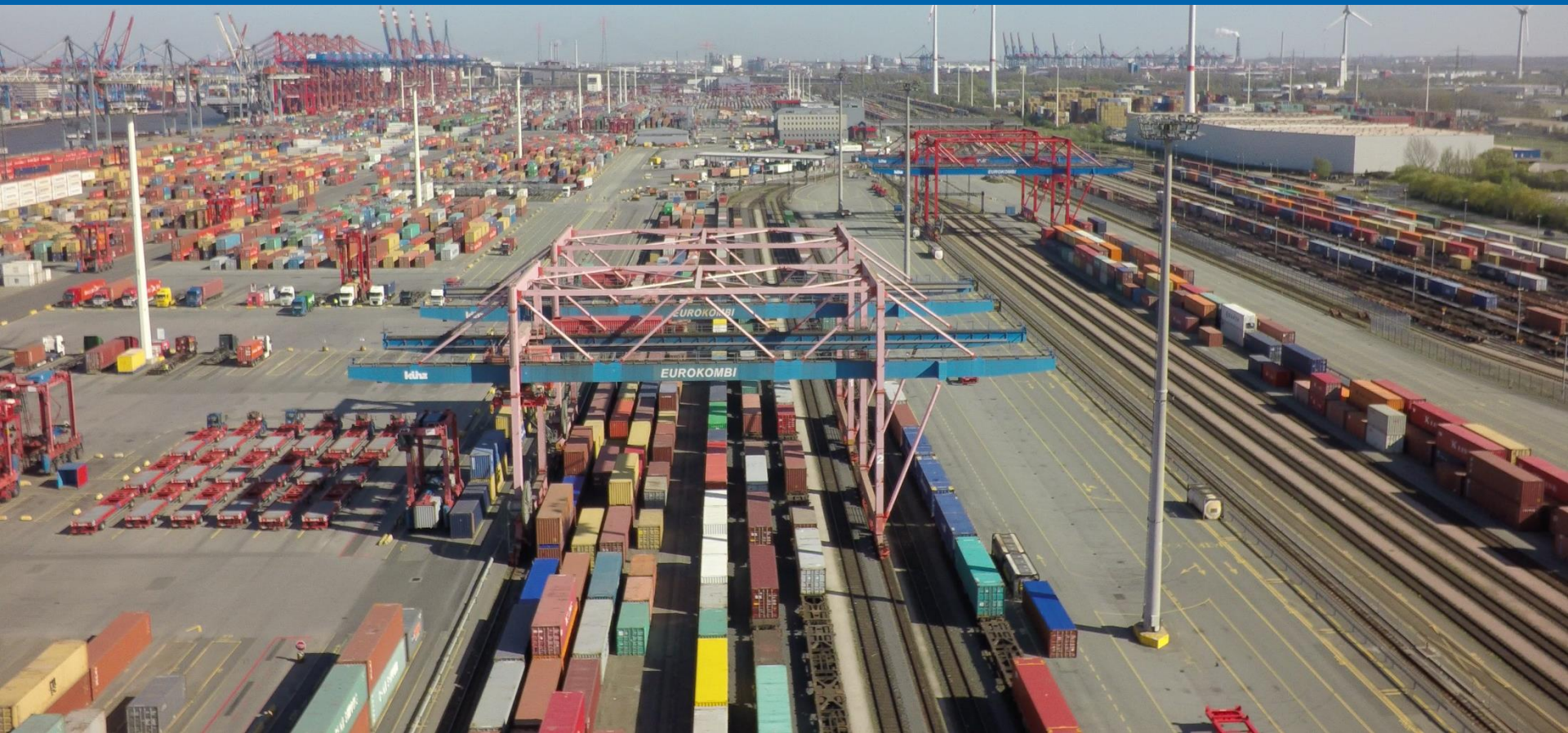
